Senate Bill 124 amended the Kansas Restraint of Trade Act (KRTA), to correct the Kansas Supreme Court's rejection of the "rule of reason" in KRTA cases, see O'Brien v. Leegin Creative Leather Products, Inc., 294 Kan. 318 (2012) (rejecting the rule of reason applied in Leegin Creative Leather Products, Inc. v. PSKS, Inc., 551 U.S. 877 (2007)); and to make clear the KRTA does not apply to franchise or non-compete agreements, or to certain other entities, arrangements, or transactions.
