ILST is a program for Venturing youth to train them

ILS is the course to assist & guide Venturers in training programs

Youth Protection is the BSA's program to maintain the safety of Scout participants in all programs. Youth Protection Champions is a new program to emphasize & highlight the importance of Youth protection.

Trainers Edge is the prerequisite course for all other adult training & provides essential planning & leadership skills (see separate flyer on Council website).

NOVA Counselor or Mentor Training provides skills to lead science and technology programs

Outdoor Ethics (Leave No Trace) is the nationally certified program to encourage proper outdoor stewardship & care during Scouting & other events

JTE Data/My.Scouting/Service Hours is a course to provide skills to unit leaders on the national quality program for troops, packs & crews including utilizing new web based resources & data input

Ecology/Soil & Water/Nature provides introduction to these various Merit Badges for Scouts & adult leaders/Merit Badge Counselors

Introduction to Training is a brand new program to explain the leadership development programs of the Boy Scouts of America

Road to Eagle is a training event to guide adult leaders in encouraging, promoting and advancing boys to the coveted **Eagle** rank

Cyber Chip is another new training course to guide adult Scout leaders at all levels on the proper usage of technology, electronic communications and Social Media in the Boy Scouts of America & introduce these leaders to the new "Cyber Chip" recognition
