

1. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a tool for tracing a trait through generations of a family. It is used to predict is a person is a carrier of a particular disease.


## "How To Read a Pedigree Chart:"

2. In a pedigree chart:

"squares" represents (males?/ females?)
"circles" represent (males?/ females?)

- 3. (Vertical lines? or Horizontal lines?) -- connect children to their parents.
- 4. (Solid? or Half-shaded?) squares and circles indicates a person is only a "carriers" of the disorder.
- 5. (Solid? or Half-shaded?) squares and circles indicates a person actually has the disorder.

(\*\*\*\*Note: If the shape is "NOT SHADED AT ALL", then the person does not have the disorder.)
