**Mission Director: Reverend Simeon Gallagher, OFMCap**  
**Theme of the Mission: *Losing and Rediscovering God***

God works through and with His people and together we can become the people He wants us to be through Fr. Simeon. Remember His promise, *“I will be your God and you will be My people.”*

Our Parish Mission begins tomorrow. Fr. Simeon will give a short Mission talk following 8 AM Mass. (We will also have Mass at 12 Noon, however, there will be no Mission talk.) The evening service begins at 7 PM and emphasizes the Word. The service will include a scriptural reading, Mission talk by Fr. Simeon, music, hymns, and prayers. The service should end around 8:30 PM.

Many people are born into a particular church but fall into a limbo of vagueness as their life progresses, believing that they have lost God along the way. However, they remain open to the vision they once glimpsed of Christianity. These lectures attempt to locate the adventure of faith within the human experience where it is possible to rediscover God. The lectures are less concerned with the contents of the Creed than in the journey toward rediscovering a basic sense of God today. Like the Christmas Magi, we look for a guiding vision that brings us out of confusion and a sense of loss into clarity and hope. The topics of the Presentations will be:

Monday’s Presentation: Matthew 2:1-12  
*“Faith: Trusting One’s own Light”*

Tuesday’s Presentation: 1 Corinthians 12:12-26  
*“Journeying Together: Community as the Birthplace for Faith”*

Wednesday’s Presentation: Matthew 7:17-27  
*“A Faith that Works: The Way of Prayer and Justice”*

Thursday’s Presentation: Matthew 2:1-12  
*“What We Receive We Share: Service as the Heart of Faith”*

If you feel the call to help, feel free to sign your name in one of the blank spaces on the schedule located on the bulletin board, after Mass. God bless you.

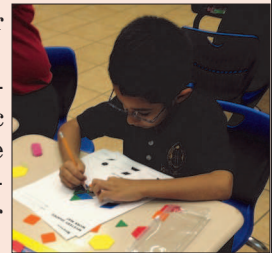

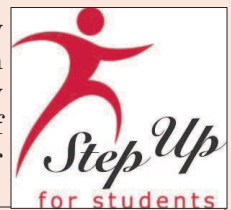

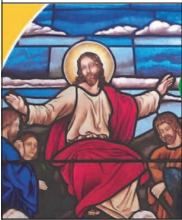
