

This month, in union with millions of Christians around the globe, we mark the 105th anniversary of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The desire for Christian unity originates in the heart of Christ. And Jesus' fervent desire is expressed clearly in the prayer he uttered at the Last Supper. Speaking of the beloved disciples whom his loving Father entrusted into his care, Jesus prays, "Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are" (John 17:11).

A few verses later, Jesus expands this prayer: "I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me" (John 17:20-21).

Spiritual ecumenism has been called the soul of the ecumenical movement. Communal, ecumenical prayer is a powerful form of spiritual ecumenism. Prayer is initiated by faith and is an exercise of faith; it moves the heart towards conversion. Prayer for Christian unity is mysteriously united to the prayer of Jesus, continually offered to the Father. It invokes the Holy Spirit and is at the same time the Holy Spirit's gift to believers.
