### Categories:

- 1. Best residential frontage display
- 2. Best residential front garden
- 3. Best commercial frontage
- 4. Best community garden e.g. Residential Home or Community Centre
- 5. Best single plant container e.g. trough, tub, planter, hanging basket During the judging week the container must have a stick or other identifier inserted, so that the judges can be sure of judging the correct container
- 6. Best street display i.e. all of the properties in a street (or part of a street) entering as a single entry. Entry can comprise several houses (e.g. 6-8 Main

Road); all of one side of a street (e.g. 2-28 Main Road)

or the whole of a street (e.g. 1-28 Main Road) At least 6 properties must be included in the entry.

i.e. front door opening onto the street

i.e. a planted area between front door and street

- 7. Best Pub Garden
- 8. Best Allotment

An <u>individual</u> residential property can be entered in category 1 OR category 2. It can also be entered in category 5 and can be part of an entry in category 6.

A <u>community</u> property can be entered in category 4 and also in category 5. It can also be part of an entry in category 6.

A <u>commercial</u> property can be entered in category 3 and category 5 and also be part of an entry in category 6. A <u>pub</u> can be entered in category 3, category 5, category 7 and also be part of an entry in category 6.

All new entrants will automatically be entered in the Best Newcomer category

#### Judging criteria:

The judges will assess on:			
1.	Initial impact	- first impression	
2.	Quality	- overall quality, cleanliness, no dead foliage, no disease	
3.	Care and attention	- dead heading, weeding and watering	
4.	Complementary	- display in keeping with the surroundings	
5.	Innovation	- display that is different and has individuality	
6.	<b>Balance and form</b>	- good colour coordination and complementary planting	
7.	General	- tidiness and cleanliness of the whole area of display

- 1. Entries must be received by Ludlow Town Council by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2011
- 2. Proof of postage is not proof of delivery
- 3. Entries will not be acknowledged
