NATURE OF WORK IN THIS CLASS:

This is complex court management and legal administrative work which involves directing, administering and supervising the various functions and mandates of the Marshals Division.

Under the general administrative direction of the Administrator of the Courts, employee in this class performs work with considerable latitude in the exercise of independent judgment and action, but in accordance with laws, rules, regulations and judicial policies and procedures.

PREFERRED REQUIREMENTS:

Master's degree in Criminal Justice, Public Administration or closely related field from a recognized college or university and eight (8) years of experience in legal, law enforcement or court work of which four (4) years must be in a supervisory capacity; or
Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice, Public Administration or closely related field from a recognized college or university and nine (9) years of experience in legal, law enforcement or court work which four (4) years must be in a supervisory capacity.

PREFERRED SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) Graduation from a recognized law enforcement certification program or academy.
- (2) Possession of a valid firearms permit.

DRUG TESTING: Applicants given a conditional offer of employment with the Judiciary of Guam will be required to submit to urinalysis to screen for the illegal use of drugs prior to appointment.
