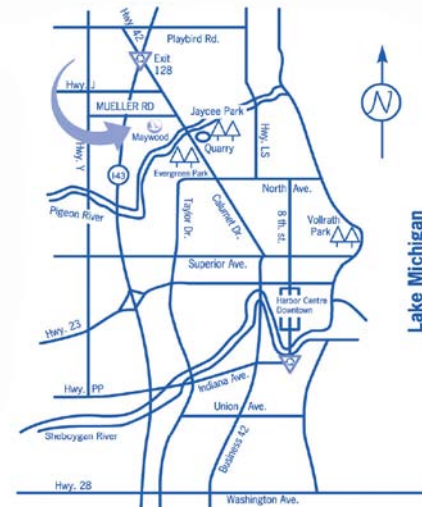

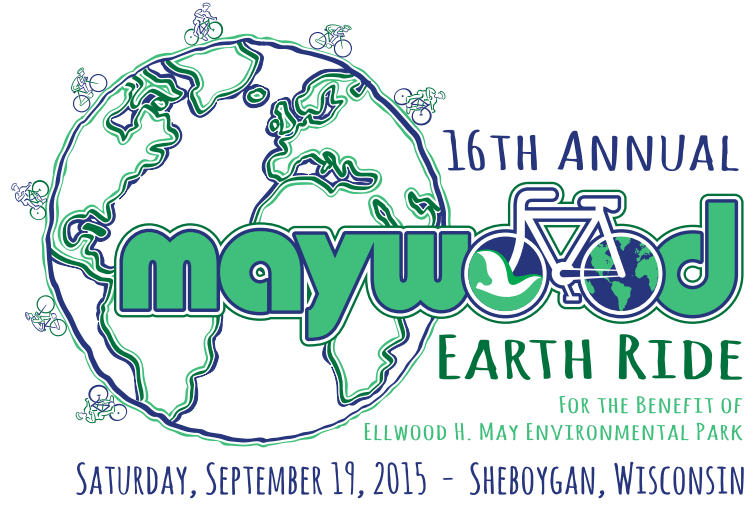

About Maywood..

The Maywood Earth Ride is a fundraiser supporting Maywood in fulfilling its mission of "Promoting environmental stewardship through real life experiences." Each year over 17,000 adults and children learn through environmental education and recreational opportunities such as school tours, family programs, natural history programs, and special events. The 135-acre park offers hiking and skiing trails and is open 365-days a year, free of charge. The Ecology Center is open weekdays 9 am-4 pm and some weekends 1-4 pm.

Family Ride

For \$55 (\$65 after 9/1) two adults and two children 12 and younger can enjoy our 12-mile route. Member families enjoy a special discount rate of \$45 (\$50 after 9/1). Additional children under 12 are \$10/child. To register, check family rate on each registration form. Family route registration must be submitted together to receive the special discounted rate. Family rate applies to the 12 mile route only.

Ride For Free!

Raise pledges of \$100 or more and receive free registration and other fantastic prizes. Fundraising is optional and benefits community and educational programs.

About The Ride

Maywood Earth Ride is a non-competitive event for riders of all ages and abilities. The Maywood Earth Ride is not a race and the course is not closed. Intersections are not guarded. Rules of the road must be observed by all participants. Rider benefits include:

- Great prizes for pledge-raisers
- Door prizes including a free bike from Wolf's Cycle
- Goodie bags to all participants
- Continental breakfast before the ride
- Lunch featuring Cousins Subs and Watson's homemade soups
- Rest stops every 10-20 miles stocked with snacks and sports beverages

- Detailed map/cue sheet and marked roads

Check-in and Start Times

Early check-in for all routes on Friday, September 18 from 1-7 pm **AT MAYWOOD.**

Day-of-ride check-in begins at 6:30 am.

12 Mile Family Route:

Check-in begins at 9:30 am; mass start at 10:30 am. 1 rest stop.

25 Mile Route:

Check-in begins at 8:00 am; mass start at 9:00 am. 2 rest stops.

50 Mile Route:

Check-in begins at 8:00 am; mass start at 9:00 am. 4 rest stops.

70 Mile Route:

Check-in begins at 6:30 am; mass start at 7:30 am. 4 rest stops, one optional stop.

100 Mile Century

Check-in begins at 6:30 am; mass start at 7:30 am. 6 rest stops, one optional stop.

112 Mile Iron Raccoon:

Check-in begins at 6:30 am; mass start at 7:00 am. 6 rest stops.
