An inspection should be conducted by the designated School Safety Coordinator two times during the school year. The first inspection should be conducted by **October 15**, **2015** and the second inspection by **February 15**, **2016**.

- 1. Complete the heading of the report.
- 2. Plan sufficient time to walk through the entire premises. Take the form along and check the appropriate responses while conducting the inspection. Take notes on serious problems discovered or on items not mentioned in this form.
- 3. After the inspection has been completed, determine what actions are required to correct the problem areas. Needed repairs or corrective measures should be reviewed by the principal.
