Pride Kicks off with an added event this year. Friday June 5th The Greater Dayton LGBT Center will present "An Affair On The Square," a beer and Food Truck Rally beginning at 5 pm to 9 pm Featuring The Rubi Girls along with additional local celebrities.



The celebrations continue on Saturday June 6th where we start the day with a hearty breakfast served up at MJ's on Jefferson beginning at 9 am with your \$5.00 donation per person going to put on Pride at Courthouse Square. At 11 am we begin lining up for the parade begins at Cooper Park in downtown Dayton.



Step off begins at noon with the Parade of marchers and floats turning right onto Third Street to Jefferson Street where

they will turn right to Second Street. At Second street the parade will turn left to Main Street where they will turn left on Main to Courthouse Square where will be greeted by throngs of folk awaiting to celebrate Pride. Mayor Nan Whaley will officiate at a mass marriage ceremony to acknowledge the love that couple share, #loveWins. The Greater Dayton LGBT Center acknowledges the love that same sex couples share and has proclaimed it will present a mass marriage each year until marriage equality is honored for all citizens in Ohio.

Pride will continue on the PNC stage with entertainment featuring the best in live vocals and local celebrity entertainment, along with energetic music. Camp Sunrise

Camp Sunrise, founded in 1994, is Ohio's only summer camp program developed specifically for children impacted by HIV/AIDS. Each summer, Camp Sunrise welcomes as many as 100 children to experience the joys of friendship, the love and support of a caring community, and an encouraging environment free of the stigma surrounding HIV/AIDS. Children living with or otherwise impacted by HIV/AIDS attend free of charge and many return year after year.

Camp Sunrise provides a unique opportunity for campers to experience traditional summer camp activities within a supportive, accepting, and encouraging community. Campers are divided by age into cabin groups – each with a theme chosen by campers themselves. Campers ages 16 and 17, known as the Sundogs, participate in teen-focused leadership programming in addition to general camp activities.

Camp Sunrise activities focus on developing friendships, trying new and different things, and having fun. For many campers, particularly the Sundogs, Camp Sunrise is also a place to address HIV/AIDS and the role it plays in their lives. To Apply: <http://www.sunrisekids.org/camper-applications>

Beginning January 1st all membership in the Greater Dayton LGBT Center become due and up for renewal. All memberships now run from January 1st through December 31st.


What does your membership do?

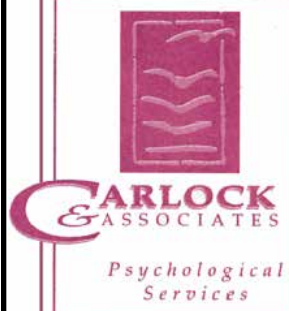

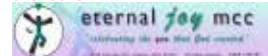
