Mock Examinations

GCSE: Friday 8 January - Wednesday 13 January

Year 11 students will be expected to attend at all times during this period where staff will be able to support them during this crucial time.

AS Level: Wednesday 6 — Thursday 7 January

- Year 12 AS students will not be required to attend their normal timetabled lessons; study spaces will be available for them to revise.
- Year 12 IB students will be expected to attend lessons as normal.
- Year 13 students taking AS courses will sit mock papers; normal timetabled lessons will continue at all other times.
