



## Buffalo Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Criteria and Application 2016

The Buffalo Area Chamber of Commerce (BACC) will award one graduating senior of Buffalo High School a scholarship in the amount of \$1,500. The selected recipient must meet the scholarship criteria and fully complete the application provided. The successful candidate, selected by the chamber's scholarship committee, will be a stand-out among their peers of the outstanding characteristics the BACC has determined for the scholarship recipient.

### **Scholarship Amount**

\$1,500

### **Criteria**

1. Be a graduating senior of Buffalo High School.
2. Be a student employee, or have a parent/guardian employed by a current (good-standing) BACC member. To view a listing of all BACC members, go to the website at [www.buffalochamber.org](http://www.buffalochamber.org) and click on Chamber Members.
3. Has applied or been accepted to a post-high school education or training program (career or business school, technical college, community college or four-year college).
4. Student must use the scholarship for continuing education.
5. Finalist must be able to meet the scholarship selection committee for a personal interview.

### **Application**

1. Neatly complete the application provided.
2. Provide detailed answers to essay questions on the application form. This should be typed on a separate sheet of paper and attached to the application.
3. Finalists in the application process will be contacted and asked to come in for an interview with the scholarship committee on May 3, 2016.

The PDF was also emailed to all chamber members in the Member Brief Bytes e-newsletter. A paper copy of the application can also be obtained from the Buffalo High School Counselor's Office or at the BACC Office. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Neatness and organization of information counts!

### **Deadline**

The application and supporting materials are due by Friday, April 22, 2016. Completed materials can be returned to the Buffalo High School Counselor's Office or to the BACC: 205 Central Avenue, Buffalo, MN 55313.

### **Award Presentation**

Once the scholarship recipient has been selected, the successful candidate will be contacted by the BACC President. The student will be invited to the Nick Miller Academic Luncheon, Tuesday, May 17 at 11 a.m., where he/she will be recognized. The student will be presented with a scholarship certificate and will be asked to announce the school and field of study intended for the fall. Since the scholarship is funded by the BACC's annual golf event, the recipient will also be invited to speak at the golf outing's award dinner at Wild Marsh Golf Course on Thursday, May 26 at 6:00 p.m. The actual scholarship funds will be released after the first term or semester of the post-secondary school is completed.

### **Scholarship Committee**

The BACC Scholarship Committee will consist of chamber members who do not have an employee's child submitting an application for consideration. The committee will review the applications and conduct interviews with the selected finalists. The committee members reserve the right of judgment concerning the selection process and the granting of the scholarship award.
