Timing

ROCK-IN RULES:

- * A minimum \$100 pledge will be required of all students to enter party, with student ID.
- * Admittance to the party will be between 8p.m-11p.m. Doors will be locked from 11pm to 5:30 am. Only Ridge Point Band & Guard students are permitted to attend.
- * Any student who must leave before 1:30 a.m. will only be released to the Parent/Guardian who signed the consent form below, with a pre-approved permission note from that parent. Anyone who leaves will not be allowed to return.
- * Students are encouraged to bring sleeping bag, pillow, and any items they may want to use during the lock-in. Please leave all money and valuables at home. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- * Absolutely no admittance will be allowed if there are any signs of alcohol or drug use. Students are not allowed to bring any types of weapon. Determination of such will be at the discretion of Security and their judgment will be final.
- * Any member of the Security staff reserves the right to eject a participant who becomes unruly or violates school policy. The Parent/Guardian giving consent will be called to pick up the student. Parent identification will be needed.
