Thursday, September 26

What's the Reason for the Season? - Seasonal Science

Have you ever wondered why our seasons change? In this hands-on science lab participants will experiment with kinesthetic astronomy to determine when is the earth closest to the sun and visit with some of the animals at CNSE CMOST to examine how animals adjust to the seasonal cycles.

Thursday, October 24

Spooky Science Magic

Join us for this fun Halloween-themed science lab. Children will experiment with kitchen potions, create invisible ink and investigate the science of pumpkins! Participants in this class will experiment with many concepts of chemistry, while having fun with the Halloween season.

Thursday, November 21

Simple Machines Investigations – Physical Science

Did you know that simple machines are everywhere in your daily life? Explore the world of physical science and simple machines in this hands-on science lab. Children will experiment with levers, pulleys, inclined planes and more!

Thursday, December 19

Who Done It? - Detective Science

Put on your detective hat and get to work in this fun class on crime science! Children will get an introductory course on the science of solving crimes. Examine fingerprints, learn about the importance of observation skills and attempt to get some insight into this fascinating field.

Thursday, January 16

What You See Is What You Get - Vision Science

What you see is what you get ... or is it? Join us for this hands-on science lab where participants will investigate the science of vision. Explore how your eyes work, dissect a cow's eye for further examination and explore some cool optical illusions and the science behind them!

Thursday, February 13

Your Kitchen's Chemistry – Chemical Science

Join us and experiment with the chemistry that is in your kitchen. In this hands-on lab children will experiment with the different states of matter, reactions and more. Cooking and baking in your kitchen will never be the same after participating in this lab!

Thursday, March 13

Too Small to See – Nanoscience

What is nanotechnology and why is it important? Join us for an investigation into all things small! Experiment with nano kits and explore nano gold, ferro fluids and more in this hands-on science lab. Children will also have the opportunity to play nano twister and a variety of other nano games!

Thursday, April 10

A Hudson River Journey – Stream Science

Join us in this exploration of stream ecology. Learn all about the science of ecology, study stream animal adaptations, examine the aquatic food web and conduct water tests in this hands-on ecology lab. Weather permitting, this lab will take place outdoors.

Thursday, May 15 Somewhere Out There - Astronomy

Join us as we explore the night sky. Create star finders, learn how telescopes work and get a tour of the night sky in the Lally Digital Dome and Planetarium during this fun and exciting introduction to backyard astronomy.
