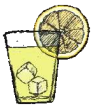

Celebrating the history of **St. Patrick School**: The St. Patrick/St. Mary School was built in 1937 (on the grounds of St. Mary) and served the children of both parishes until 1951, when St. Patrick built its own parish school. The school was staffed by The Sisters of Mercy. In 1970, the two parochial schools were merged once again. With the consolidation, the names for both schools became **Montini Catholic School**, with the St. Patrick school building serving the lower grades, and thus, being referred to as Montini Primary Center.

All parishioners, young and old (especially alumni), are invited to join us for **brunch** at the **McHenry Country Club on Sunday, July 26th, at 12Noon** as we continue our **175th Anniversary Year Events**. The celebration will include:

THE TRINITY IS LOVE

Theologians throughout the Christian centuries have spilled much ink (and, on occasion, some blood) in describing and defining the mystery of the Holy Trinity. One of the earliest, most poetic, and beautiful descriptions comes from St. Augustine in *De Trinitas*, wherein he describes the Trinity as One (the Father) who loves, One (the Son) who is loved, and One (the Spirit) who is love. And these three Ones are also one Three.

It might be wisest for us to leave the technical wrangling to the academic theologians, and focus on the fact that the three Persons of the Trinity are indeed persons; they are best known and understood in their love for each other and for us. We are made in the image of those loving persons, and our best relationships are lived out in the context of love. Truly loving relationships are inexhaustible mysteries to be lived in joy. If this is true of our human relationships, how much more so is it true of our relationship with the Trinity. And how much more does it call upon us to be joyful, loving witnesses of the holy mystery of the One-in-Three. This is the mystery to which we were called when we were chosen to be God's own, baptized with water in the name of the Holy Trinity.

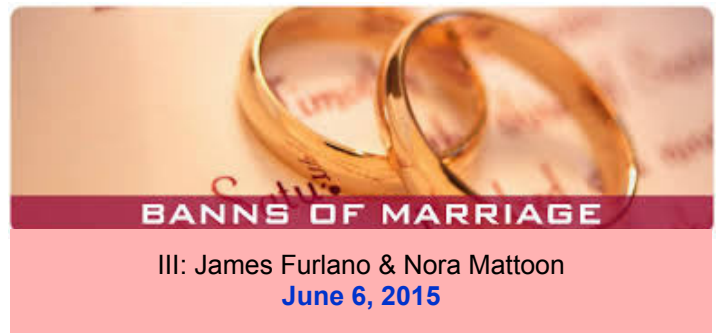

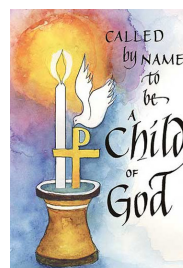

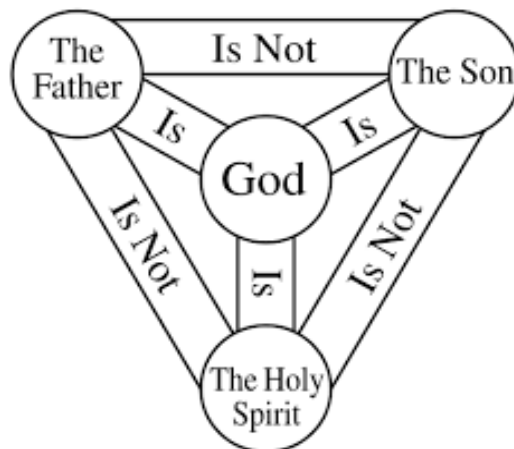

Vocations Corner: House on Rock

Sometimes in life we may find ourselves in a situation where we don't quite understand what God is trying to do or what He is calling us to. We may become very confused and even begin to question how good can come from the situations that we find ourselves in. At this point we simply have to TRUST, which is of course easier said than done. In these moments I like to meditate on the Gospel passage of the house built on rock vs. the house built on sand. The interesting thing that you find if you read the passage carefully is that the rains, the floods and the winds come against both houses. It isn't as if the person who built the house on a solid foundation won't have to endure the trials. However, in the midst of the storm, if we establish the foundation of our lives on Christ, than we will have a place to go. The storms may rage on outside, but we can remain at peace inside. I often like to envision myself inside the house, with Jesus sitting across from me. He is always peaceful, inviting me to follow his lead.

So, when you find yourself in the midst of the storm, make the choice to keep its effect outside where it won't overwhelm you or take your gaze off of Christ. Remain inside, with Christ, so that He can assure you of His constant help and protection.

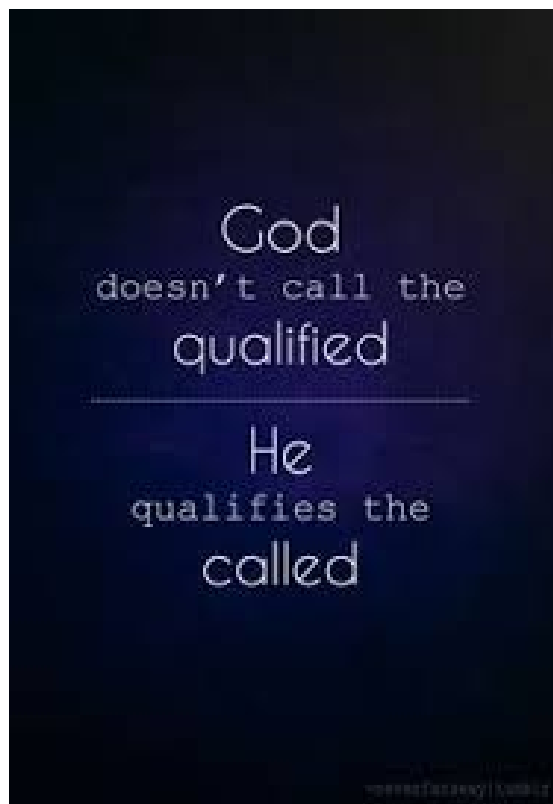

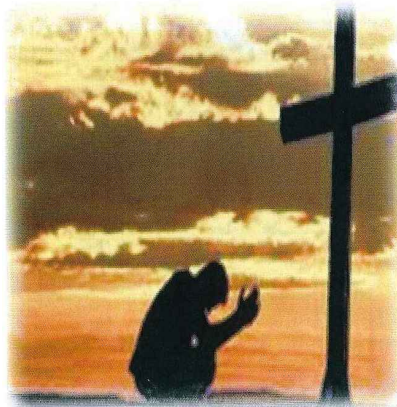

Sacraments

Baptism of Infants:

To schedule a Baptism, please begin by calling the parish office. Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month immediately after the 11AM Mass. Please consider scheduling your child’s Baptism before your child is born to ensure an opening in the month of your choice. In addition, a Baptismal preparation class is required for the parents. This class is offered on the 1st Sunday of each month after the 9AM Mass. Sign-up is required and you may take the class before your child is born.

Sacrament of Marriage:

At St. Patrick, couples planning to marry need to meet with the Pastor before a wedding date can be set. Please contact the parish office to setup an initial meeting at least 6 months prior to any requested marriage date. This initial meeting will give you an overview of the requirements for marriage and the preparation required. **At least one of the couple, or their parents, must be registered parishioners for at least 6 months and be active participating members of St. Patrick Church in order to be married at the church.** Both individuals must be at least 19 years of age.
