Bidermann Golf Club: The most exclusive club you never heard of

Bidermann had its beginnings as a 9-hole course, designed in the 1920 by the respected and prolific architect Devereus Emmet, and laid out across the hills and meadows of the private estate of Henry Francis DuPont, adjacent to what is now Wintherthur Museum and Gardens.

It remained du Pont's private playground until 1963, when he was approached by his cousin, George Weymouth, who convinced him there was the need for a "small, intimate club devoted solely to golf".

In addition to DuPont's estate, his cousin Emily du Pont, and avid golfer, kicked in an adjacent parcel, giving them 300 acres.

In the beginning, there was only one club rule: "Ball must be lifted from any flower bed and dropped no nearer hole without penalty." This remained the only club rule because Weymouth was insistent that given the size and quality of the membership, rules were unnecessary.

In 1977 Bidermann merged with Vicmead Hunt Club and has approximately 300 members.

The Classic - Formerly known as The Dickie!

The Classic has been held continually since 1995 on the third Monday of July! Now celebrating it's 20th year at Bidermann, each year it provides a day of golf, fellowship and fun for those participating. The Chair of this event over the years has featured many leading businessmen from the State of Delaware. Each Chair has brought their own attention to detail to make their event most profitable for the community. The original name of this event, "The Dickie", was named after the late Dick DiSabatino a founding member of the Board. "Dickie" wanted to hold a golf outing, and convinced everyone that it could happen! With the help of the late Leonard Quill, who sponsored us in 1995, we have enjoyed the outing for the last 20 years. This fundraiser supports the mission of the community to provide emotional support and educational workshops **at no cost** for people with cancer and their families.
