## CAMPER INFORMATION FORMS

The Rady JCC and the Manitoba Camping Association require that camper information forms are completed in full and submitted to the Rady JCC no later than two weeks prior to the start of each camp session to ensure information is current, or your child will be unable to attend camp. If information changes, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to let us know so we can update camp record.

## STAFF

All Rady JCC Summer Day Camp staff is chosen by their experience, ability to relate to children and leadership skills. Staff receives training which includes program development, CPR & First Aid Certification, water safety, and inclusion training. All staff is screened through the Child Abuse Registry and Criminal Records Search to ensure the safety of all campers.

## LUNCH AND SNACK OPTION

**\$55 per each week of camp / \$50 for week 5**

Lunch and Snack option is offered for SHEMESH (Preschool Day Camp), RUACH (Full Day Camp) and for KESHET (Full Day Camp). In conjunction with Schmooser's Café, we will provide a hot lunch, drink, fruit and morning and afternoon snacks each day. The Lunch and Snack option is non-refundable, available on a weekly basis only and must be paid for at time of registration. ## FREE PRE & POST CAMP CARE
