IMPORTANT: Resignation Deadline December 31

Registrants have an obligation to complete the annual registration renewal process by the November 1, 11:59pm EDT deadline. If you intend to resign at the end of the current calendar year (effective January 1 of the following year), you are not required to renew your registration but must ensure a completed *Resignation Form* is received by the College in advance of the December 31, 11:59pm EDT registration expiry date to avoid suspension of your registration.

Registrants resigning from the profession are reminded that the *Certificate of Registration* (wall certificate) remains College property and must be returned to the College after resigning. Failing to return a wall certificate and photo ID card to the College when requested constitutes professional misconduct pursuant to Section 26, paragraph 23 of the professional Misconduct Regulations, Ontario Regulation 544/94 as amended.

Returning to the Profession:

To return to the profession after resignation, you must satisfy the registration requirements of *Ontario Registration Regulation 864/93*, as amended, under the *Massage Therapy Act, 1991*, including the <u>non-exemptible</u> requirements <u>as a new applicant</u>. The regulations require a re-assessment of the original training to determine if it is *substantially similar* to the current Ontario *Massage Therapy Competency Standards*. Successful completion of the current OSCE and MCQ certification examinations is not required. Further training in an approved Massage Therapy program or a Refresher program may be required.

Registrants are advised to consider maintaining an Inactive (IN) status of registration if a potential to return to active practice exists. Inactive registrants can return to GC status without completion of the certification examinations.

If you wish to keep your wall certificate as a memento of your Massage Therapy career, the College can stamp your certificate so that it is marked "Resigned" and return it to you. There is a \$10.00 fee for this service, which is payable by cheque or credit card.
