

Explore this peaceful place on the Sussex Downland, home to many species of waterfowl. Hire rowing boats in summer on Swanbourne Lake. Free entrance

This is a 65-acre reserve in an idyllic setting, nestled at the base of the South Downs National Park. Gliding through the reed beds in silent electric boats is a great opportunity to glimpse a rare water vole or see vividly-coloured kingfishers. Another prized resident is the nene, the goose saved from extinction by WWT founder Sir Peter Scott and still one of the world's rarest water-birds. Springtime fills the valley with wildflowers and warbler songs; summer brings exciting pond-dipping discoveries; as winter starts, Bewick's swans return and water rails emerge. Families enjoy the year-round attractions like the pond skaters adventure, a tree creeper play area and daily hand-feeding of the many birds. ARUNDEL Arundel Castle

Set high on a hill in West Sussex this great castle commands the landscape with magnificent views across the South Downs and the River Arun. Built at the end of the 11th Century it has been the home of the Dukes of Norfolk and their ancestors for nearly 1,000 years. Many of the original features such as the Crenellated Norman Keep, Gatehouse, Barbican and the lower part of the Bevis Tower survive. Between the 1870's and 1890's the house was almost completely rebuilt and the magnificent architecture in Gothic style is considered to be one of the great works of Victorian England. With finely preserved interiors, fascinating furniture, tapestries, rare art collections by renowned artists and beautiful well-stocked gardens – Arundel Castle provides the perfect day out. The latest attraction, The Earls Garden, was opened by HRH The Prince of Wales. Open 1st April-31st Oct, Tues-Sun and Bank Hols and Mons in Aug. Please visit the website for opening times.
