English-Version Informed Consent

(IRB Approved)



- The investigator provides a qualified <u>interpreter</u> to present orally the informed consent information and to facilitate the discussion
- By answering and asking questions, the investigator determines whether the subject comprehends the consent information to ensure the informed consent id valid

Signatures required:

- 1. Interpreter/Witness
- 2. Person obtaining consent

A fully signed copy is given to the subject
