Tour Cost: The price of The Friends of Spivey Hall (FOSH) 2015 Summer Travel Program is **\$4,986.00 per person for double occupancy and \$5,330.00 per person for single occupancy, ground only.**

Trip includes: Touring with Sam Dixon, Executive & Artistic Director of Spivey Hall; nine (9) nights in 4-star Hotel Sonne Lifestyle in Mellau, Austria; ten (10) buffet breakfasts, nine (9) lunches, and nine (9) 4-course dinners; use of spa facilities at hotel in Mellau; visitor card with free use of chairlifts & public transport in Mellau; tickets to twelve (12) concerts; private coach transfers to concerts; excursion to Kartause Ittingen with light lunch; excursion to Angelika Kaufman Museum & village church; excursion to Rolls-Royce Museum in Dornbirn; excursion to Lindau with boat to Bregenz including lunch; ride on narrow-gauge railway from Bezau to Schwarzenberg; excursion to Birnau pilgrimage church, Constance & Rhein Falls; all excursions with private English-speaking guide, Gabriela Steiner-Scharfetter; transfers from Zurich airport to hotel in Mellau on June 19, & from Mellau to Zurich on June 28 including an overnight stay at Steigenberger Hotel Bellerive au Lac. Final Payment: The balance must be received by Spivey Hall not later than **March 1, 2015**.

Payments/Cancellations: The first payment, due with the signed Registration Form not later than **October 10, 2014**, is considered a deposit for this trip and is **non-refundable**. In addition, your deposit is considered your commitment to pay for the remainder of trip cost. The overall price of the trip is based on number of attendees; therefore, once your participation is confirmed, you are responsible for the total payment per the schedule outlined above. Participation is confirmed upon receipt of fully-completed Registration Form and processing by Spivey Hall of deposit, on a first-come-first-served, space-available basis.
