#### **Terms and Conditions**

KidsCan is a charitable trust that supports the education of children in low decile New Zealand schools by supplying food, shoes, socks, raincoats, basic hygiene items and various other items free of charge to schools for distribution to children enrolled at those schools who are in need of the items. The items are supplied by KidsCan through the following programmes: 'Raincoats for Kids', 'Shoes for Kids', 'Food for Kids', 'Health for Kids' and 'Orchards in Schools'. Partner Schools can participate in one or more of these programmes.

The Partner School may, from time to time via the KidsCan website (or in such other form or timeframe as notified by KidsCan), send KidsCan its order requirements for the items. Following supply of the items, the Partner School will distribute the items as soon as reasonably practicable to the children enrolled at the Partner School who are in need of the items (primarily to ensure school attendance) and will use its best reasonable endeavours to not stockpile any of the items.

The Partner School acknowledges, and will ensure that the parents or caregivers of the children are aware that items supplied as part of the Schools Programmes are to be distributed to and used solely by the children receiving the items and are not at any stage to be distributed to, used, worn or consumed by the parents or caregivers of the children or any other third party.

The Partner School will not, under any circumstance, charge any fee to the children or the parents or caregivers of the children in relation to the distribution of the items; use any of the items in whole or part for fundraising purposes; or allow any of the items to be used by staff or employees of the Partner School or any members of the Board of Trustees whether for personal use or use at any events or functions.

The Partner School will keep complete and accurate records of the quantities of items distributed to and/or used by students through the programmes, and the results of the programmes on the students. KidsCan may schedule a visit to the Partner School by phone or email at any time, with the view to building a quality, long-term relationship with the Partner School. During the visit, the Partner School will make the records available to KidsCan as well as any other information as may reasonably be requested by KidsCan regarding the effectiveness of the programmes.

Where reasonably requested by KidsCan, the Partner School agrees to provide annual feedback to KidsCan on the Partner School letterhead, and to provide images, letters of support and any specific feedback from the students or the Partner School in relation to the delivery of the programmes which may be used for KidsCan publicity, marketing and advertising, fundraising from local grant providers, and for sponsorship proposals as KidsCan deems appropriate.

The Partner School acknowledges that KidsCan is a high profile charity gaining regular positive media exposure, creating more awareness of poverty and encouraging people to donate. In light of this, the Partner School must not and must ensure that its officers, employees and agents do not engage in any conduct or activity that will harm or is likely to harm, KidsCan's name, reputation or good standing; or which is offensive, corrupt or disreputable.
