Key Club International has a brand guide on their website that contains instructions for graphic standards to help make your documents look like Key Club. One way to do this is through fonts. The six fonts on the left are the Key Club graphic standard fonts. **Use them for everything!**

Century Gothic, Goudy Oldstyle, and Verdana usually come standard, and Walk Around the Block can be downloaded for free at www.dafont.com/walk-around-the-block.font. You can purchase the other fonts if you really want to, but it is not necessary.

EDITOR IDEAS

If you are your club's editor, here are some ideas to keep your current members informed and to recruit new members.

- **Create a website.** A website is a great way for members to stay up-to-date with current club info. Add a calendar to keep track of upcoming service projects, and post meeting agendas in case someone missed a meeting.
- **Start a social media account.** Social media can be used to send out quick reminders about upcoming events and meeting dates. A Remind account works well for this too.
- **Make a poster or presentation for orientation.** Back-to-school orientation is an awesome opportunity to get the word out about Key Club before the school year even starts. Ask your principal if you can give out handouts or give a presentation at the event.

This newsletter will be discussing ERFs, monthlies/minutes, and ICON!

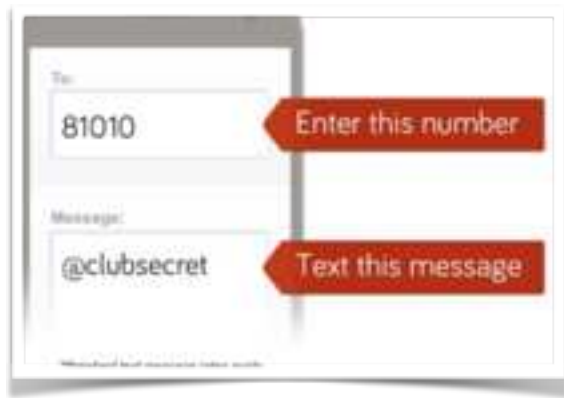
First, one of my duties as secretary consists of making the district directory, which contains all of the contact information for all clubs. If your club wishes to be included in this and has already held elections for officers for the
