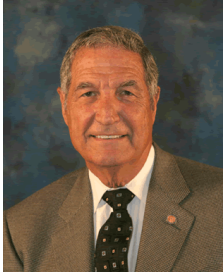

Gene Stallings was born March 2, 1935 and is a former football player and national champion head coach. He played college football at Texas A&M University (1954-1956), where he was one of the "Junction Boys," and later served as the head coach at his alma mater from 1965 to 1971.

Stallings was also the head coach of the St. Louis/Phoenix Cardinals of the NFL (1986-1989) and at the University of Alabama (1990-1996). Stallings' 1992 Alabama team completed a 13-0 season with a win in the Sugar Bowl over Miami and was named the consensus national champion. Stallings has been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame, Alabama Sports Hall of Fame, Texas Sports Hall of Fame, Texas A&M Hall of Fame, Gator Bowl Hall of Fame and Cotton Bowl Hall of Fame.

Stallings has also received many humanitarian awards, including the Arthritis Humanitarian Award of Alabama, National Boys Club Alumni of the Year, Dallas Father of the Year, Humanitarian Award of the Lion's Club of Alabama, and Paris Boys Club Wall of Honor.



Jeff Speegle is the weekend sports anchor at ABC 33/40, joining the team in 1996 when the station signed on the air. Jeff is a native of Alabama, born in Cullman County. He's also worked as a sportscaster in Tuscaloosa and Huntsville.
