Misting and Watering: Aison in Orchidland Dec 2012

I do not have a greenhouse, but rather a sunroom that has furniture and a tiled floor that opens onto our living room. So I can't just hose everything down. Over the years I have maintained a daily program for my plants. From Nov-Apr. I mist all plants before sun-up.

After breakfast I turn on 2 humidifiers. I have a rechargable, battery operated mister that emits a powerful, fine mist. The humidifiers are Venta (German Co.) which I purchased at Eastman's Hardware, Falmouth. Since I cannot maintain humidity at 60-70% throughout the day I place cattleyas and other humidity driven orchids nearest to the humidifiers. By April I am opening windows and doors allowing humidity in naturally.


