

# Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

F xult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven,

exult, let Angel ministers of God exult,

let the trumpet of salvation sound aloud our mighty King's triumph!

(Fxsultet - Faster Proclamation)

With these words, we begin our Easter Vigil. The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night is "the greatest and most noble of all solemnities" (Roman Missal, p. 197, #2) in the Church. It is the night in which, with glad exuberance, we bask in the benevolent light of our eternal King, Jesus Christ, our Lord and the Only Begotten Son of the eternal Father.

Through the radiance of the glory of his cross, Christ "constantly invites us to rejoice" (Evangelii Gaudium 5), to exult in his Gospel – the Gospel of life and of love.

# Congratulations to our newly initiated Catholics! Great Work!



The Religious Education/Formation students are taught certain prayers which are part of the rich history and tradition of the Church. The **Angelus** is one of those famous prayers taught through the centuries to honor the Blessed Mother. We are reminded with this prayer to turn to our Lady three times a day, or at least once a day, usually at 12:00 Noon. It remembers both the Annunciation of Our Lady and the Incarnation of Our Lord. During the time of Easter another prayer is said. From Easter Sunday through Pentecost Sunday, the **Regina Coeli** is to be said in place of the **Angelus**. The following is the prayer.

### **REGINA COELI**

Queen of heaven, rejoice! Alleluia.

The Son whom it was your privilege to bear, Alleluia, has risen as He said, Alleluia.

Pray to God for us, Alleluia.

Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, Alleluia!

For the Lord has truly risen. Alleluia.

Let Us Pray O God, You gave joy to the world through the Resurrection of Your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. We ask You through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother to bring us to the happiness of eternal life. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.
