The Maryland Center of Excellence on Problem Gambling (The Center) is committed to growing the Maryland Problem Gambling Treatment Provider Network (Maryland GamNet), a network developed to assist those and their families struggling with gambling addiction.

If you are a counselor who is integrating problem gambling in your clinical work, and are willing to accept new clients, we invite you to be listed on the Maryland Problem Gambling Counselor Referral List. This public list allows individuals seeking help to find a counselor trained in gambling treatment. The Referral List is accessed on the MARG (Maryland Alliance for Responsible Gambling) website (<a href="www.mdgamblinghelp.org">www.mdgamblinghelp.org</a>) and The Center's website (<a href="www.mdgambling.com">www.mdgambling.com</a>).

## Requirements for inclusion on the Referral List:

- Training:
  - As of today, completed a minimum of 30 hours of problem gambling specific training.
  - o Obtain a minimum of 10 problem gambling specific CEU's annually.
  - o Complete a minimum of 60 hours total by June 30, 2016
- Case Consultation Calls:
  - o Participate in a minimum of 8 Case Consultation calls annually.
- Monthly Surveys:
  - Complete a brief problem gambling services survey each month Disordered Gambling (DG) Treatment Provider Monthly Report. This report is due the 5th of each month for the prior month.
