A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION REVISION REQUEST FOR CORPORATE PARKWAY IN THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and Chapter 127, paragraphs 741 through 748, of the Illinois Revised Statutes, authorizes and encourages intergovernmental associations and cooperation; and

WHEREAS, the public officials of the McHenry County Council of Mayors represent twenty nine (29) local government bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Algonquin submitted a Functional Classification Revision Request application, herein attached as Exhibit "A", to the Planning Liaison on February 19, 2015, requesting a functional classification revision for Corporate Parkway from Local Road or Street to Minor Collector. The endpoints of said roadway are Randall Road and Boyer Road.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the McHenry County Council of Mayors concurs with the village and requests that the Illinois Department of Transportation revise Corporate Parkway functional classification from Local Road or Street to Minor Collector upon final approval from the Federal Highway Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution will be forwarded to the appropriate officials at the Illinois Department of Transportation and the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning.


