GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS

To be considered for the CCPSA Jan Powers Memorial Scholarship, a student must:

- Graduate the spring semester of the current school year from a Corpus Christi ISD high school.
- Intent to pursue post secondary education (priority given to education majors)
- Enroll full-time (12 hours or more) during the fall semester following high school graduation at **Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi, Texas A&M University-Kingsville, Del Mar College or Coastal Bend College** (the student is expected to maintain full-time enrollment for both the fall and spring semesters)
- Submit a transcript indicating at least a 3.0 grade point average

The following should be submitted in one envelope

- Two (2) copies of the application form and essay. It is preferred that this form be used. A copy machine reproduction is acceptable.
- A copy of the student's official transcript
- One (1) sealed letter of recommendation from each group (1) principal or assistant principal; (2) counselor or teacher (3) organization sponsor or employer. *No more than three letters should be submitted.*
