Open Burning, of yard waste only, begins September 15th and ends December 1st. Fires must be out by dark. Burning of any trash, leaves, rubbish or other combustible material in any curb and gutter (culverts included) or on any paved or surfaced street or alley is prohibited. Report illegal fires to the Jones County Sheriff's office. **To prevent plugging of storm culverts do not put yard waste into storm or street ditches. There is no dumping allowed in Little Bear Creek.**

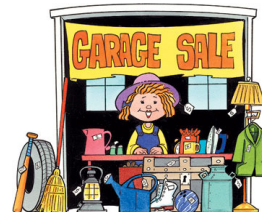
Flushing Hydrants
