Each year, Bright Beginnings prepares nearly 150 homeless children to enter kindergarten ready to read and ready to learn, while also helping their parents to transition out of homelessness and achieve self-sufficiency.

Louis is a Bright Beginnings parent who was recognized by the White House Fatherhood Initiative for his positive presence and influence with his family and in the community. He recently shared his gratitude for the difference Bright Beginnings has made in his life and for his family: "How can I describe an organization and a group of people who have taken the strain, the stress and the worry off my family even though we are homeless? My children have been here for the last four years and I know they are safe, loved and learning when I go off to work. I prayed for a better life for my kids. Bright Beginnings was the answer to that prayer."

Bright Beginnings, which has served nearly 2,300 homeless children, makes a significant difference in the lives of young children and their families who are facing a shrinking social service network, scarce housing options, and a challenging job market. Families with young children are among the fastest-growing segments of the homeless population. At the end of the most recent school year, more than 200 children were on the waiting list to enroll at Bright



Beginnings, which is one of only two programs in the District specifically designed to address the needs of these families.
