From the Campbell High School Student Handbook (page 41)

Participation in extra-curricular activities and athletics is a privilege. **In order for student to be eligible to participate, they must meet initial eligibility requirements by passing a minimum of two and one-half academic credit courses for the previous marking period.** In order to maintain their eligibility, students must conform to the rules of the school and work to their fullest potential in all their classes.

A student who, in the opinion of a teacher, is not maintaining satisfactory performance academically or behaviorally may be placed on probation for eligibility for co-curricular participation. The student and his/her parent or guardian will be notified in writing by the teacher as to the reason for being placed on probation, the specific performance that needs improvement and the length of time in which the student must correct the performance. A student may continue to participate in co-curricular activities while on probation.

If satisfactory performance is achieved within the probationary period, the student will be taken off probation. If satisfactory performance is not achieved within the prescribed time period, the student will be declared ineligible and may not participate in any co-curricular activities until the teacher determines the student is demonstrating satisfactory performance.

Students may appeal any and all eligibility rulings to the Principal, whose decision is final.
