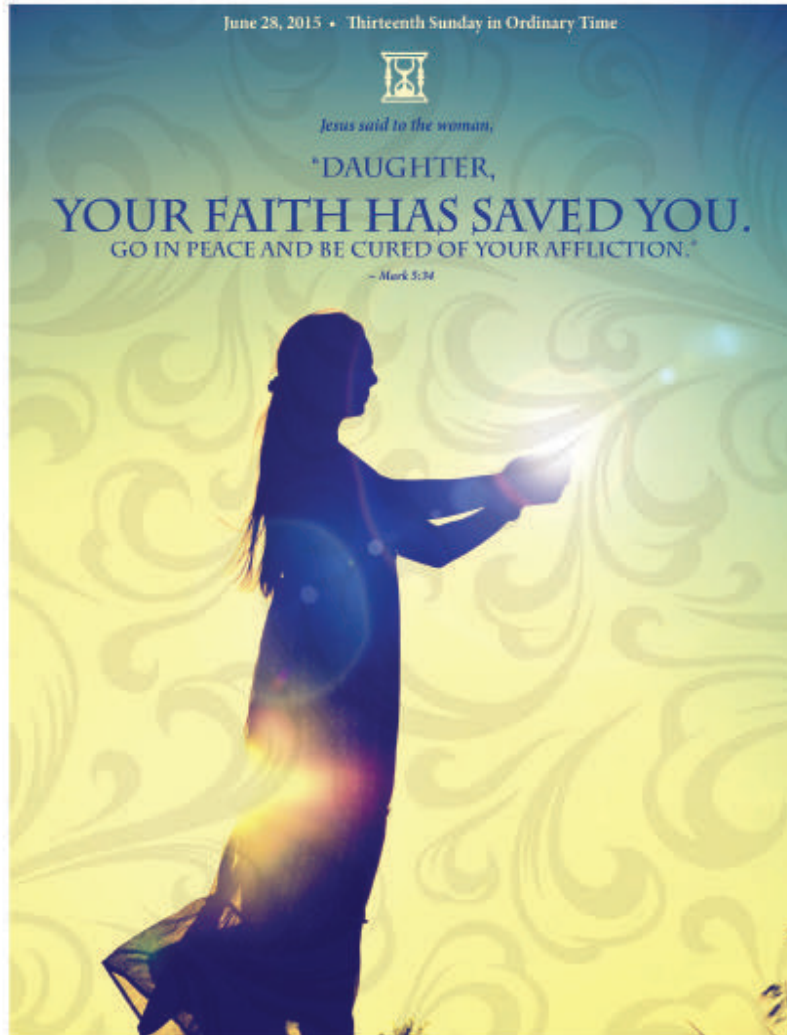

Dear Parishioners,

These past two weeks - these last few months really – have been very painful and divisive in terms of the news cycle. We have seen shootings across the country and in our own community, violence towards one another, and the issue of race and class continue to lead the evening news headlines.

What has happened these past few days in Charleston, South Carolina at Emmanuel A.M.E. Church is a tragedy and the deaths of the nine church members including their pastor are deplorable. The unspeakable actions that took place in their church go against God's design.

In this weekend's liturgy of the Word, we hear from the book of Wisdom, "God did not make death, nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living." As Christians we believe that the taking of all human life is wrong. God has created us in His image and likeness and so to take the life of another is to go against the Lord. Regardless of where one stands politically, this event, and events like it, shake our innermost being because we know that what has occurred is fundamentally not right and even sinful. Our prayers as a community are in solidarity with all those who mourn with Charleston and the people of Emmanuel AME Church.

We are called to be people of peace. Let us work for peace. Let us pray for peace: peace in our homes; peace in our communities; peace in our country; peace in our world. Let us also pray for wisdom and courage to be able to address the issues that lead to violence so that we may work for a world of peace. May the peace of Christ be with all of us and may his love and grace touch the hearts of all people to make a positive change in this world.

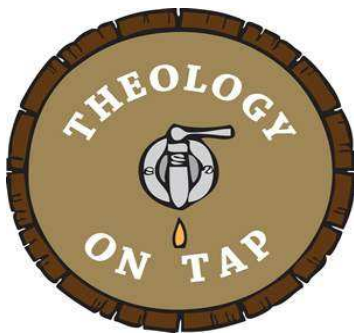

Connecting Hearts through Education:

- *Two schools have been built providing education for over 400 students
- *A third school is under construction for 250 students
- *Over 100 pairs of many of your shoes were provided to school children



Connecting Hearts through Scholarships:

- *100 scholarships are provided for students' tuition



Connecting Hearts, Parish to Parish:

- *Bikes had been purchased to allow for transportation for ministry
- *Medical supplies were taken for care of the sick
- *Hygiene kits have been shipped for students and families:
- *Financial support for St. Charles Parish, Lwanga, Fr. Matthias' parish, continues
- *18 outstations (communities Fr. Matthias services that are too far to attend his parish) benefit from that support

Another immersion trip is in the planning stages for the Fall of 2016. 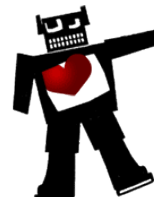
