Portable Electrical Testing & Tagging

Conduct in-service safety testing of electrical cord assemblies and cord connected equipment (UEENEEP026A)

Amendments were made to the OSH Regulations to allow a competent person to test and tag portable electrical equipment for use on a construction and/or demolition site. As required by the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Regulations the course provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to test and tag portable electrical equipment on demolition, construction and mine sites.

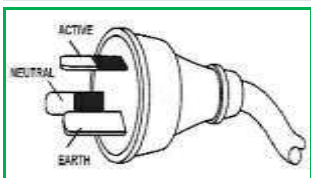
Pre-requisite: It is required that you have obtained the Work Safely in the Construction Industry CPCCOHS1001A (white card) obtained after October 2009, and to provide a copy of your Statement of Attainment together with your registration form.

On successful completion you will receive your Statement of Attainments for UEENEEP026A Conduct in-service safety testing of electrical cord assemblies and cord connected equipment and UEENEEE101A Apply Occupational Health and Safety regulations, codes and practices in the workplace.

Attach cords & plugs to electrical equipment for connect to a single phase 250 volt supply (UEENEEP002B)

This unit covers attaching flexible cords and plugs to electrical equipment for connection to supplies up to 250V a.c. It encompasses working safely, identifying plug configurations, selecting and using testing and measuring devices, terminating and connecting cords/plugs and conductors, safety testing and reporting.
