SILENT AUCTION PROCESS OTHER NOTES OF INFORMATION

About the items and initial process

- 1. The Silent Auction will open at 8:00 p.m. and close at 11:00 p.m.
- 2. All auction items have a bid sheet with a minimum bid and bid increment printed on each sheet.
- 3. Minimum bids generally start at a substantial discount to the retail value of the item to encourage lively bidding.

Bidding on an auction item

- 1. If you are the initial bidder, you must enter the minimum bid permitted for that item and write your name, assigned bidder number, and seating table number next your bid amount.
- 2. If someone has already bided on an item, and you wish to enter a bid, you must enter an amount higher in accordance to the stated minimum increment for that item (i.e., increment amount is \$5.00 higher than previous bided amount)
- 3. Bidding will continue until auction item sheets are pulled indicating that bidding is closed.

Settling your account and claiming items
