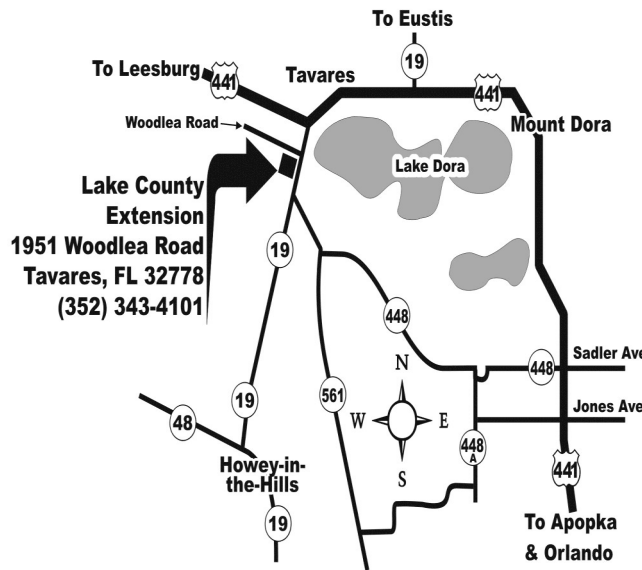

What is GI-BMP Training?

- Offers a science-based educational program
- Provides landscape management recommendations to the Green Industries
- Designed to conserve and protect Florida's water resources and environment

This workshop is designed to provide training in Green Industries Best Management Practices (GI-BMPs) for anyone working in the lawn, landscape, pest control, or municipal grounds areas.
