# Fourth Sunday of Advent (year B) December 18, 2011

What can you do for a God who has already loved you so much? Give your heart to God and be prepared like Mary to take some risks.



Often during the advent season, I am scared to go out shopping. Isn't it amazing that a baby born in a stable 2,000 years ago can cause traffic jams on our streets and long queues at the counter this week?

Christmas poses a yearly challenge to those of us who have heard the story since we were children. After you have attended 20 or 30 or 40 or more Christmas

celebrations, and heard (and sung) every Christmas carols a few hundred times, what more is left to be said that hasn't been said before?

If we know about Christmas at all, we know about Mary and the angel Gabriel, about the dangerous journey to Bethlehem, about Caesar's decree, about Herod's insane jealousy, about the "No Vacancy" at the inn, about the angels and the shepherds, and about the mysterious Wise Men from the east, and the unplanned last-second flight into Egypt. All of these stories are so well known that when we hear them again, we don't really hear them at all because we've heard them all before. In reality, we hear but we don't hear.

That is indeed a problem. *Familiarity can breed, if not contempt, at least a kind of casual disinterest*. This is sad because, the story of Christmas is indeed full of surprises! And after all, it tells the most amazing story: That God invaded human history in the form of a tiny, helpless baby.

One of the best ways to fight such a tendency is to focus on the details. Sometimes it helps to take out the microscope and study just one tiny fragment of the story. By looking closely at a small part, we may see the whole thing in a new light. The verse I have in mind is one that we will be hearing next Sunday and comes from the first Christmas sermon—preached by an angel to some very frightened shepherds. After announcing that a Savior had been born in Bethlehem, the angel tells them how to find the baby. **"This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger".** 

Let's continue our journey to the manger like the shepherds to love and to behold the Christ born for us all!
