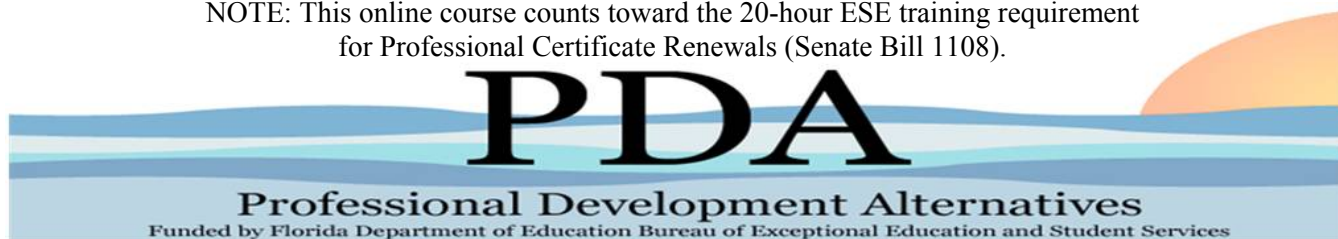


NOTE: This online course counts toward the 20-hour ESE training requirement for Professional Certificate Renewals (Senate Bill 1108).

PDA: Instructional Practices (60 inservice credits)
