Cyber Safety Parent Meeting Monday Sept. 28 6:30 PM

We would like to invite you to attend The Michigan Cyber Safety Initiative (CSI) parent presentation on Monday, Sept. 28 at 6:30pm. The seminar provides relevant research about how students are using technology and offers Internet safety tips and practical tools. The presentation will cover how to understand the impact of digital footprints, realize the risk of sharing photos with embedded location information, identify the possible privacy risks of different apps, recognize the potential dangers and legal ramifications of sexting; and identify cyberbully warning signs and develop a plan of action. In addition, the presenter will discuss OK2SAY, a student safety program that allows students to confidentially report tips on potential harm or criminal activities directed at students, school employees, and schools.

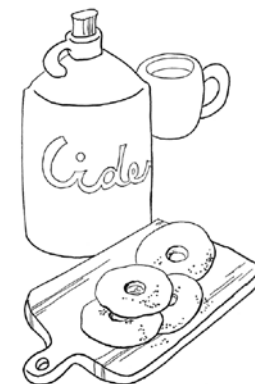
