#### SOUTH BUFFALO INVESTMENT GROUP, INC. - SITE PLAN - CAPITOL PARK DRIVE - APPROVED

#### J. BAUMAN PLAN NO. 3 - SUBDIVISION - SINGLETON ROAD - APPROVED WITH CONTINGENCY

Jeanne Bauman Swaskoski is proposing a subdivision of her property located on Singleton Road. Proposed Lot #9 is 14.574 acres; the residual lot is 12.5+- acres.

The township office has received Copy of Plan, Filing Fee, Fee In Lieu Of, Butler County Planning Commission comments (BCPC did not have any comments on this plan as per letter dated 10/23/15), Twp. Engineer comments (Lot 9 description and area shall be revised to include frontage along road right-of-way, near N/F Mufford Property. Additionally, should have dedicated 25 foot wide right-of-way-half of the required 50 foot width – along northern side of road. A North Arrow and scale shall be shown on Vicinity Plan. Highway Occupancy Permit note is not applicable, Singleton Road is a Township Road, and should be removed from plan. Sewage Facilities Planning Certification or Waiver shall be denoted on plan. All developers of residential subdivisions or residential land developments shall give due consideration to the provision of sites for recreational use areas, or pay fee in lieu of as per fax dated 11/4/15), Municipal Authority comments (Public water service is not available; sanitary sewage service is not available as per letter dated 11/4/15), and Twp. Planning Commission comments (favorable recommendation contingent on the Planning Module as per 11/4/15 meeting minutes).

Ken Howard stated that Stan Graff has revised the drawings and addressed our concerns. The only outstanding item is the Planning Module.
