1. WORLD MEDIATION FORUM (WMF)

1.1 INTRODUCTION

The World Mediation Forum http://www.mediate.com/world/ (WMF) is an association of people, organisations and institutions interested in interpersonal, intergroup, transcultural and international mediation. Its main purpose is to spread and exchange knowledge regarding mediation. A conference is organized every other year in different parts of the world.

The WMF was started in Dublin, Ireland in 1993 after the first International Conference on Mediation. It was formally constituted at an Assembly during the First Conference of the WMF at El Escorial, Spain in 1995. The other Conferences were located in Havana, Cuba in 1998, Sardinia, Italy in 2000 and Buenos Aires, Argentina in 2003.

1.2 OBJECTIVES

The WMF Conferences aim to:

- > stimulate exchanges of ideas and thoughts between practitioners, researchers or any person involved in conflict management at local, regional or international level
- facilitate a comparative analysis of various models, cultures and practices of mediation.
- > explore the place and responsibility of mediation in the changes it leads
- promote mediation in the management of conflict in various fields of professional and social life.

The three conference days will include presentations and exchanges through plenary sessions, round tables and workshops

2. THE 5TH WMF CONFERENCE

2.1 ORGANIZER: INSTITUT UNIVERSITAIRE KURT BÖSCH (IUKB)

The 5th WMF conference will be organized by the academic Institut Universitaire Kurt Bösch (IUKB: www.iukb.ch), officially named by the Government of the Swiss Confederation on November 11, 1992, according to the 2nd article of Swiss Federal Law from March 22, 1991 regarding Swiss Universities (LAU). Through its postgraduate training, its programs of continuing education and its research projects, the Institute promotes inter and trans-disciplinary exchanges for the study of the social, environmental and cultural characteristics of our society.

2.2 LOCATION: CRANS MONTANA

The 5th World Conference of the WMF will take place in Crans Montana (http://www.crans-montana.ch) at the Congress Centre "Le Régent" (http://www2.congres.ch/). Located in the heart of the Alps, 1500 metres high, it is surrounded by magnificent natural scenery and is close to the resort center with easy access to various forms of communication, business and accommodation.

The location offers an excellent environment to combine work and relaxation : something few other resorts can offer.

Thanks to its renovation the Régent is a high-quality centre with flexible rooms and technical possibilities (simultaneous translation, electronic connections, access to internet etc.).

2.3 GEOGRAPHICAL SITUATION

Crans Montana is a high plateau, facing south, 1500 metres high, in the middle of the Swiss Alps.

Crans Montana is located 240 km from Milan, 190 km away from Geneva, 280 km from Zürich, 20 km from Sion et 15 km from Sierre.

3. PROGRAMME OF THE 5TH CONFERENCE

MEDIATION: A NEW CULTURE OF CHANGE

The worldwide application of exchanges, the opening of borders, increased travel and migration are issues for our societies and bring changes in political, cultural, social and familial institutions, as well as in the environment, posing challenges for various state and international organisations.

Mediation is an effective approach for managing the conflicts that arise from societal and environmental changes.

It is considered more and more as a way of reinforcing citizenship by favouring durable politics of development in the world.

3.1 KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Renowned individuals will be invited by the Organizing Committee to give a paper lasting 45 to 60 minutes, followed by a plenary debate for 30 minutes (see website).

3.2 PRESENTATIONS (SESSIONS AND WORKSHOPS)

Researchers, academics or practitioners who would like to make a presentation related to one of the themes listed below must send their proposal (the title and a summary of 5,000 characters) and a CV to the Organizing Committee by **March 31, 2005**. A Scientific Committee will be appointed to evaluate the proposals (see web site).

3.3 THEMES

Each of the themes can include any of the fields of mediation. We suggest a comparative approach based on the following themes:

THEME 1: History of mediation

The origins of mediation, its theoretical foundations, practice developments and institutionalisation.

THEME 2: The contexts of mediation

The various fields of mediation and their relationship to other modes of conflict management.

THEME 3: Mediation: a new paradigm of conflict management

Changes lead by mediation in the social regulation of conflict.

THEME 4: Mediation and contemporary problems

The position of mediation with regard to the challenges of our contemporary society including: the increase of violence, migration and armed conflicts.

THEME 5: Mediation and sustainable development

The contribution of mediation to new strategies of urban governance (towns, cities, districts, cross-border, global), the management of natural resources and the protection of the environment

THEME 6: Mediation and intercultural relations

Mediation on the management of problems arising from ethnic and cultural differences as a way of facilitating cohabitation of different ethnic groups and indigenous communities and relations between them.

4. PRE-CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS

The purpose of the pre-conference workshops is to enable registrants to attend practical workshops during the two days before the conference.

Each of these workshops will be conducted by one or two presenters who will focus on different themes related to mediation. They will be in different languages but without translation. Numbers will be restricted. (see website)

A certificate of participation established by the WMF and the IUKB will be issued. Registrations must arrive before **June 30, 2005**.

5. PRESENTATION OF EXPERIENCES AND/OR PROJECTS

5.1 Poster session

The World Mediation Forum aims to facilitate the spread of information and exchanges between practitioners or institutions. It also aims at promoting mediation and the development of a culture of responsibility and peace in any type of conflict.

The IUKB and the WMF will organize rooms for mediators or institutions who are willing to present their experiences or projects. This will offer a real chance to develop synergies and potentials.

Any person or institution willing to present an experimental or innovative project in the mediation field (practice, training or research) may send this project (a summary of 1 or 2 sheet with a CV of 20 lines) before **March 31, 2005**. People who want to present their project will have the possibility to do so during the Conference. (see website).

A specially formed Committee will examine these projects during the Conference and will present an award of distinction to three.

5.2 Audio-visual projections

In the same spirit as the poster sessions, a room will be available for individuals or organisations wishing to present projects or experiences through videos or powerpoint displays.

Those projects (summary of 15 lines and a CV of 20 lines) must be sent to the secretary of the Conference before **March 31**st, **2005**.

Please take note that you need to do an inscription at the Conference to have the possibility to make these presentations (posters or audio-visual projections). A limited number of posters and projections could be presented at this occasion.

6. EXHIBITIONS

The Congress Centre "Le Régent" provides comfortable rooms for exhibitions. Firms or institutions may ask the possibility to exhibit their products or projects during the Conference.

A presentation can be made beside each stand, slots in the timetable will be proposed to the chosen projects.

The costs and room availability may be requested from the Conference secretary. The requests must be made by **June 30**, **2005**. Exceptionally the later requests could be examined if the space is sufficient.

7. OFFICIAL RECEPTION

An official reception will be organised on September 10. 2005 on evening. The prices are: Group I: 40 Euros / Group II: 60 Euros / Students: 30 Euros.
