





CLASS SPECIFICATIONS AND INFORMATION

- 1. You can save \$2.00 per class by pre-entering by the pre-entry deadline! NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE DEADLINE!
- 2. Classes marked with an asterisk (*) are point classes in the respective divisions. If you are competing for high point, please list.
- 3. Trail Classes will be held from 1 PM-4 PM riders are responsible for completing trail within that time period
- 4. Gates open at 4:00 P.M. Friday night; NO EXCEPTIONS?!!!
- 5. Classes 28, 29, 52, & 53 are non-pointed and are for experienced riders not eligible for walk/trot classes, with green horses.
- 6. Ages as of September 1, 2007: Juniors/Intermediate 8-13, Seniors 14-17, Adult 18 & Up, Open All ages 8 & up eligible
- 7. Walk /Trot classes are for riders who have NEVER cantered at a show before. Once a rider has cantered at a show, they can NOT return to the W/T division. Walk-trot riders are limited to all the halter classes, walk-trot classes (except classes 28 and 52), beginner showmanship, crossrails, and beginner trail.
- 8. Florida State 4-H Horse Show Official Rules apply.
- 9. Negative Coggins test required and paperwork will be checked.
- Relaxed attire (sleeved, collared shirts) permitted. Boots with heels required for all riders. Sleeveless shirts are NOT permitted. Approved SEI/ASTM helmets with chinstraps for English, Speed, and Western rider's 17 years old & under as of 1 Sept 2007 <u>MUST BE WORN</u> when riding a horse. This pertains to the entire show grounds from time of arrival until departure. Failure to comply may result in disqualification. A helmet is not required for Western in-hand classes.
- 11. Two-minute gate call rule will be in effect and fee will not refunded for missed classes. The public address system is a courtesy. It is the rider's responsibility to be on time for all classes. Any requested tack changes between classes will not exceed two minutes.
- 12. Cancellation of a class must be made 1 class prior to cancelled class. NO REFUNDS. Classes may be combined or cancelled due to insufficient entries.
- 13. The official judge may be called upon to rule on any questionable equipment.
- 14. Bandages (leg wraps or polos) are not permitted in any class. Bits subject to be checked. Bits may not be wrapped (see page 10-11 of the Florida State 4-H Horse Show Rule Book)
- 15. Decisions of the judges are final.
- 16. Each contestant will accrue points according to division listed per horse and rider combination. Six place ribbons per class at each show.
- 17. Show High Point Ribbons will be given at each show. Point Categories are: Walk-Trot 8-13 English, Walk-Trot 8-13 Western, Walk-Trot 14 & Over English, Walk-Trot 14 & Over, Western, English 8-13, English 14 & Over, Western 8-13, Western 14 and Over, Speed 8-13, and Speed 14 & Over. Awards given for Summer Series High Point in respective divisions, pending sponsorship. Minimum of 3 entries at each show constitutes a division. Must have attended 2 of 3 shows.
- 18. No stallions permitted on the show grounds. No dogs except on a leash.
- 19. Proper shoe attire required when walking in rings and schooling areas (closed toe shoes). Please do not lunge your horse in the covered arena or in designated warm-up areas. Lunging must be done in the grass parking areas outside the chain link fence behind the parked horse trailers.
- 20. Management may stop or cancel a class in progress due to storm, accident, or other emergency.
