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EXTRACT FROM THE PHILIPPINE IMMIGRATION OF 1940

(As amended by R.A. 118, R.A. 135, R.A. 144, R.A. 503, R.A. 749, R.A. 1901, R.A. 4376, R.A. 5171, R.A. 5701 and P.D. 524) AN ACT TO CONTROL AND REGULATE THE IMMIGRATION OF ALIENS INTO THE PHILIPPINES

Section 29.(a.) The following classes of Aliens shall be excluded from entry into the Philippines:

- (1) Idiots or insane persons and persons who have been insane;
- (2) Persons afflicted with a loathsome or dangerous contagious disease, or epilepsy;

For other exclusions, see Commonwealth Act No. 613 and P.D. 524

EXCERPTS FROM BUREAU OF QUARANTINE MEMORANDUM 2014:

As directed by the International Health Regulation of the World Health Organization, additional requirements shall be presented by concerned immigrants:

- 1. Yellow fever vaccination(YFV) Certificate for foreigners from African and South American countries identified by the World Health Organization as yellow fever endemic zone.
- 2. **Polio Immunization Record** for nationals coming from Cameroon, Pakistan, Syria Afghanistan, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Iraq, Israel, Nigeria and Somalia.
 - Concerned foreigners without Polio Vaccination Certificate shall be immunized by the Government or any DOH accredited hospital/clinic.
- 3. Malaria Smear test result for aliens from Africa, South America, Vietnam, Bangladesh, Cambodia, Myanmar, Indonesia and Papua New Guinea. These areas have high prevalence of asymptomatic malaria cases and are endemic with multiple drug resistant malaria strain. Persons with positive Malaria test shall need treatment certificate and a post treatment malaria test.

Original document/s should be presented before the corresponding copy is accepted.

X-ray and Laboratory exams should be within the six months validity period

VISA APPLICANTS REQUIRING BOQ/CONSULAR MEDICAL CLEARANCE:

- A. Non-Immigrant
 - 1. Student
 - 2. Applicants for pre-arranged employment visas
- B. All Immigrants
- C. Applicants obviously afflicted with a Class A condition
