

# Child Abuse Prevention Month April 2016 Children's Art Contest

## **CRITERIA:**

- Open to all children in grades 3 - 5;
- Children should create a picture related to awareness of child abuse prevention and/or nurturing families
  - ⌘ Pictures may be on paper size (8 ½ x 11) up to standard poster size (24 x 36) horizontal
  - ⌘ Pictures can use any type of medium (charcoal, markers, paint, construction paper, etc.)
  - ⌘ Picture should include a slogan related to the theme of child abuse prevention and/or nurturing families
  - ⌘ Entries may be completed by an individual child or a group of children (only one prize will be awarded regardless of size of group creating the artwork)
  - ⌘ All submissions must have completed Consent Form signed by parent/legal guardian (attached)
  - ⌘ **Entries should be submitted or delivered in person by March 18, 2016, at 4:00 p.m.** to Family Nurturing Center, 8275 Ewing Blvd, Florence, KY 41042.

## **PRIZE:**

The winning entry will receive:

- ⌘ An 8-week Afterschool Arts Workshop at The Carnegie
- ⌘ Pizza party for school classroom, church group, or youth club/organization.
- ⌘ Public display in April Child Abuse Prevention Month marketing efforts, which may include: art work converted to a poster and displayed on all TANK buses, agency newsletter, website, certificates, t-shirt, print/electronic media outlets
- ⌘ The winner will be asked to attend the Blue Ribbon Ceremony to kick off Child Abuse Prevention Month on Friday, April 1st, at 11:30am, hosted by Tom Gill Chevrolet, Florence, KY.
