A HISTORY OF HOW ARBOR HALL CAME TO BE

PART FOUR FINAL INSTALLMENT

Contributors to this story will be acknowledged at the end of the final installment.

It has been mentioned earlier that donations were a little slow at first. We were asking a lot but most of the dancers believed in what we were trying to do. Some donated more than asked, some a little less, but we were thankful for every contribution. There were two large private donations, one locally and the other from Cincinnati. Every local privately owned dance studio donated including one farther North and one South. All of the DJ's also donated. There were 185 individual contributors to the floor and sadly now just 50 (27%) are still dancing on it. The Cincinnati area always supplied many dancers to Arbor Hall and they contributed "big time". Now we are in tough economic times and the clubs are in a mild crisis, attendance is dwindling and expenses are increasing. The one "ace in the hole" is the New Year's Eve dance. It was billed this past year as a fundraiser. In the past it was simply, put on a very nice dance and don't spare the expense. Now that idea must be shelved. We must now turn a profit to help make up for the losses throughout the year. The Dance(tonians) decided on not hosting the New Year's Eve dance since they needed to turn their attention to the Dance Fair. The Swing'n'Sway and '76 Club will host the New Year's Eve dance on alternate years. We hope we can count on the support of all of the dancers like the ones ten years ago. We have a very nice facility and it would be a blow to lose it after so many gave so we could have a place where all of the dance clubs would be together. Thanks.

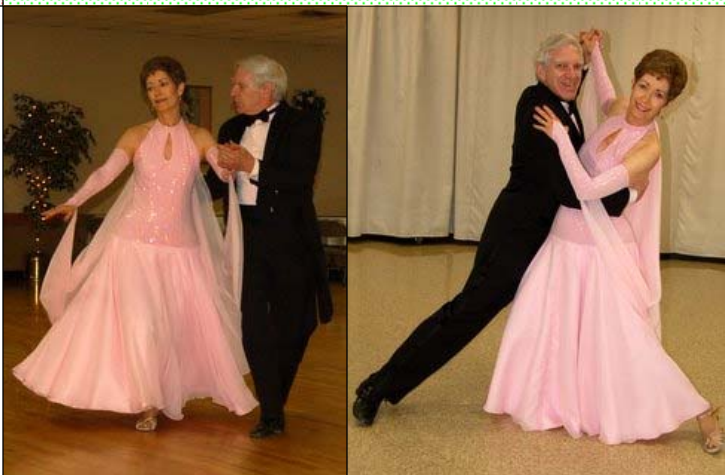
