GUIDELINES

1. All dogs participating in Paws for a Cause will be screened at check-in. The Iowa City Animal Care & Adoption Center & Friends of the Animal Center Foundation have final authority on the suitability of any animal to participate.

Because of the large number of dogs participating, the event directors reserve the right to refuse entry to any dog whose participation could prove hazardous to the others or if conditions are not favorable for the animals.

Disqualifications include, but are not limited to, overly aggressive behavior by a dog or human; female dogs in heat or advanced pregnancy; dogs in poor/questionable health; and mistreatment of any dog.

- 2. Proof of rabies vaccination (rabies certificate) is required for all dogs over 4 months old to participate. Copy of the certificate may be mailed with registration form or brought to event. A rabies tag alone will not suffice ONLY if it has BOTH vaccination administered AND vaccination expired date.
- 3. All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 10'. No retractable leads.
- 4. Two dogs allowed per paid entry.
- 5. Owners are responsible for scooping after their doas.
- 6. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
