Due to a rule change, effective September 2002, all dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC. One week before the show

You will receive a Superintendent packet in the mail about a week before the show. This packet will contain:

Confirmation entry slip- A single piece of paper with your puppy's name, armband number, class entered and other information will be included in the packet. Take this to the ring with you so you can ask the Ring Steward to give you the right armband number to wear in the ring so the judge can identify you.

Judging program- This multi-page pamphlet contains an index of all breeds at the show. It will tell you how many dogs are entered, what ring number you will be in, what time to be at the ring, and directions to get to the show among other helpful information.

What do I do on the day of show?

Get up early! The morning of the show, feed your puppy earlier than usual so your puppy can do her business before you get on the road to the show.

What to pack- You'll want to bring water, a water bowl, and a brush for last minute grooming, and treats to give your puppy after a job well done. Don't forget to pack the very important clean-up bags for potty breaks, your Superintendent packet and a chair for yourself.

On the road- Remember traveling in a crate is the safest form of transportation for your puppy. Plus, having the crate at the show will give your puppy a place to rest before and after the fun.

At the show grounds- Make sure you arrive at least one or two hours before your scheduled ring time so that you can set up a spot to watch the show near your ring, take your puppy for a walk to potty, and then observe the show to get an idea of what to expect in the ring.

At the ring- Before your scheduled ring time, find your ring and ask the Ring Steward to give you your armband number (show her the confirmation entry slip with the number). This number is placed around your left upper arm and secured with a rubber band available at ringside. Don't forget to dress in business casual attire with comfortable walking shoes so both you and your puppy look your best.

What will the judge ask me to do in the ring?

Ringside- Once your time has arrived, the Ring Steward will call all the puppies in the class according to armband number into the ring for judging.

Stand in line- At first, all the puppies will stand in line together for the judge to give all those cute puppies a first look. What will the judge ask me to do in the ring?

All together- Then the judge will ask all the puppies to trot around the ring in one big circle together. Following those in front of you, ask your puppy to follow you around the ring in a slow jog until you reach the end of the line.

Meet and greet- You and your puppy can relax for a moment now. The judge will ask each puppy to come up to him for an individual "meet and greet." At this point, the judge will

greet your puppy and ask you to open her mouth to look at her teeth. He will then place his hands around the puppy's body for further examination.

Strutting pup's stuff- The judge will ask you to individually trot your puppy around in a "pattern" - maybe a triangle or a straight line- and then back to the end of the line.

Get a ribbon- After all the puppies have been looked at by the judge, you will go around the ring as a group one more time. At this point the judge picks his winners and hands out ribbons. Congratulations!



4-6 Month Puppy Class

This year the German Shepherd Dog Club of Minneapolis & St. Paul will be holding their first 4-6 Month Puppy Show. This should be a great event for everyone whether you're a hard-core dog show goer or just a casual spectator. Enter your puppy or just come to see the other puppies, you might even get a kiss or two.



Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations

Amended by AKC Board of Directors April 2013

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule. if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be
 handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or
 has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised
 or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants
 and household members of a professional handler.

Section 3 – Titles

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex. Group winners will be eligible for the highest number of points earned by any breed within that Group. Best Four-to-Six Puppy in Show will be eligible for the highest number of points earned by any breed entered. The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

Section 4 – Ribbons

Ribbons for Groups and Best Four to Six Puppy in Show will be as follows:

- Best of Breed Orange
- Best of Opposite Sex Lavender

- Group 4 Gray
- Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show Pink & Green
 It is recommended that all participants receive a token of participation in this event.

Section 5 – Administration

Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition will be offered in a separate ring(s) from the regular class judging in order to avoid delays in the judging of regular classes. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Entry fees will be determined by the show-giving club. The show results and event service fee of \$2.00 per entry must be submitted to AKC Event Operations within seven (7) days of the event (electronic results submissions are preferred).

Clubs holding Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition will receive credit for completing both a Major Activity as well as an Additional Activity for judges gaining experience on their unapproved breeds by judging at the event. *Dealing with Misconduct* will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Section 6 – Judging

 Individuals that have an AKC conformation judge's number are the required judges for the Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition. Judges assigned regular classes may not judge the Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition if it interferes or delays the judging of regular classes, Groups or Best in Show. The judging conflict requirements of 30 days and 200 mile between assignments will not apply to the Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition. A change in the listed judge due to an overload will not result in a return in the entry fee.



PREPARING YOUR PUPPY FOR A DAY OF FUN!

Welcome To The AKC 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

Congratulations on your new AKC registered purebred puppy! Puppyhood is an exciting time of exploration for all puppies and yours is no exception. It is also the best time to socialize them by going to new places, meeting new people and discovering new activities. Below are some helpful tips to help you and your puppy get off on the right paw as you have a day of fun at the 4 to 6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

How do I enter the 4-6 Month Puppy Class?

In order to participate in the fun, you must enter your puppy at least twoand-a-half weeks before the show. Every dog show has a "premium list" that has all the important information about the show, including an entry form. You must fill out the entry form (either online or by mail) with the information about your puppy and which class you want to enter, i.e. the 4 to 6 Month Beginner Puppy class.

Each show has a **Superintendent or Show Secretary** who processes all the show entry forms. Contact the Superintendent listed to receive the show's premium list and entry form or find them online. To complete an entry form, you'll need your dog's AKC registration number, a credit card or check and your dog's AKC registration certificate so you can fill out your puppy's "official registered" name, her dam's (mother's) name, her sire's



(father's) name as well as her birthdate, breeder's name and your contact information. You will also check off the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy class. Once you submit your entry form with entry fee, the Superintendent will send you a confirmation of the entry via mail and email if you entered online.

How do I prepare my puppy for the show?

It's a good idea to have your puppy ready for fun before you go to the show.



Walking on a leash- Your puppy should be comfortable wearing a collar and walking on a leash by your left side. You may have been taught this as the "heel position" in your puppy kindergarten class. This is easy to practice at home before going to the show.

Meet me- Puppies love people so be prepared for her to meet lots of new people at the show! You may want to get her ready to meet people by taking your puppy to a park or other public spaces to get her used to the activity.

Looking her best- Don't forget to groom your puppy as part of the preparation. If she is really dirty, as some puppies can be very active outdoors, then maybe a bath a day or two before the show is in order. But, at the very least, make sure she is brushed and free of dirt, debris and any tangles in her hair. Also, if it's been a while since you trimmed her toenails, you may want to give them a quick trim too.
