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Monroe-Woodbury is again offering a Summer Enrichment Program for Monroe Woodbury District residents and non–residents. Non-residents will be charged a surcharge of \$10 per course.

This program is totally self-sustaining with all costs paid by the fees collected for each course. Last year over 3000 students and adults participated in the courses offered. The following points should be noted:

- Courses will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis, with priority give to Monroe Woodbury
 residents who register before <u>June 30, 2015</u>. Students may choose more than one course if
 desired. There is no waiting list.
- Registrations are accepted throughout the duration of the Summer Enrichment program.
- Registrations before July 2, 2015 <u>must</u> be done by mail on the form at the end of this booklet or the form found at <u>www.mw.k12.ny.us.</u>
- Registrations after July 1,2015, should be brought to the Summer Enrichment Office located at the M-W Middle School.
- Checks should be made payable to the <u>Monroe-Woodbury School District</u> (MWCSD).
- There will be a \$10.00 processing fee for all course transfers, except for transfers precipitated by the Monroe-Woodbury Summer Enrichment Program.

- All course transfers and cancellations must be done in person at the SE office after July 1, 2015. No changes will be accepted by email or phone.
- Most classes will be held in the buildings or on the fields of the school district. All students must provide their own transportation.
- In inclement weather all efforts will be made to move outside classes to indoor locations, if this is not possible the class will be cancelled for that day.
- If there is an austerity budget, a fee will be collected by the instructor the first day of class.
