- ✓ Contact Little Red School House at 425.353.5656 or candy@littlered.org and tell Candy you want to create or join a team. **Mail or fax (425.513.2807) your Team Registration Form by May 1st, 2009.**
- ✓ Make sure each Team Member has a **Sponsor Pledge Collection Sheet**
- ✓ All Team Members then sign up sponsors who pledge a set amount. Aim high! You and your team members are competing to see who can raise the most for Little Red families.
- ✓ Sponsors can pledge to donate a “per pin” amount for your two games at 10 cents, 25 cents, or 50 cents per pin.
- ✓ To have even more fun, challenge family, friends, co-workers (even your boss!), to form a team and compete for the highest donation per pin!

On average, Little Red staff serve 600 Snohomish County children and their families every year – and we could not do it without your help and generosity!

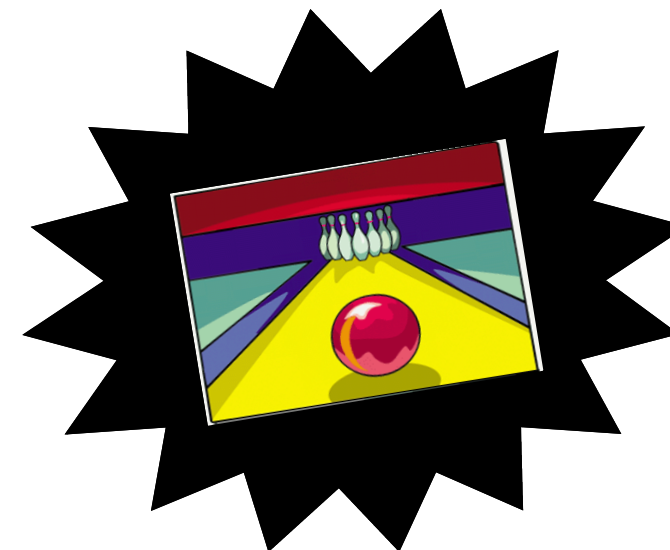
How Bowling Changes Lives
