- ✓ 1 Three-Ring Binder (8 1/2" x 11" size)
- ✓ **10 Pocket** Dividers (**plastic** ones PLEASE)
- ✓ Graph paper (**four** squares to the inch, make sure there are squares on both sides)
- ✓ Wide-ruled binder paper
- ✓ 70 page spiral notebook (no perforated pages, please)
- ✓ Rosary
- ✓ set colored felt-tipped markers
- ✓ pointed scissors
- ✓ 6 - #2 pencils (**Bring three to school and keep the rest at home.**)
